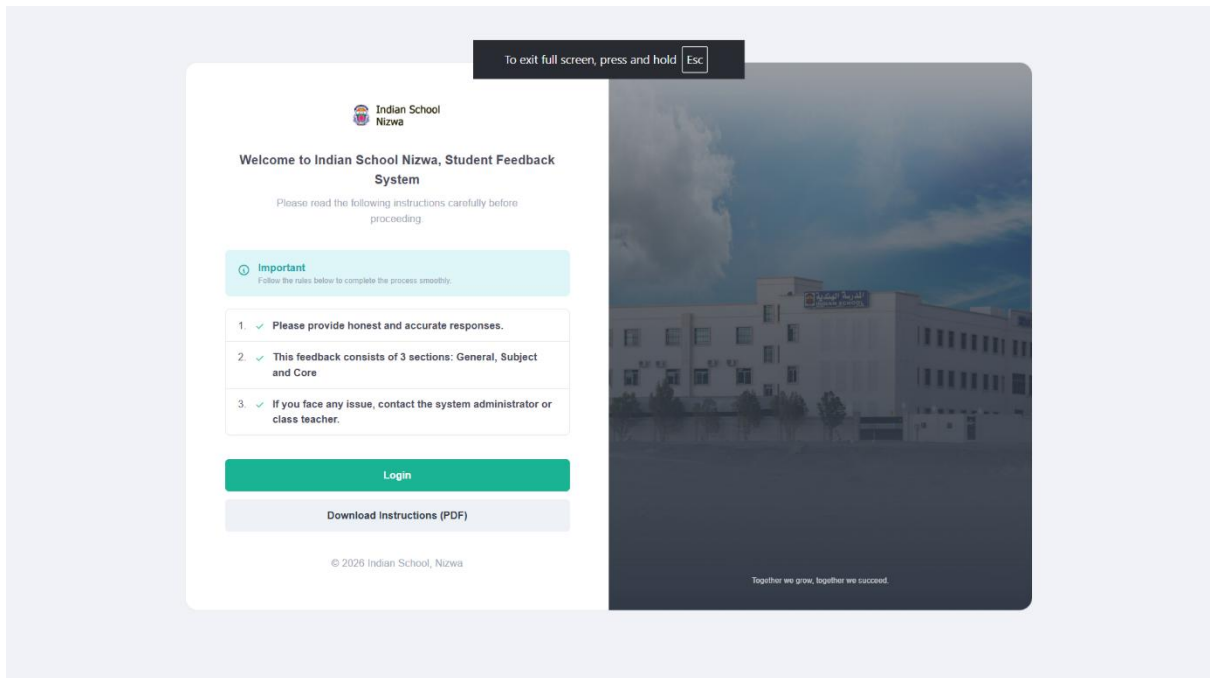
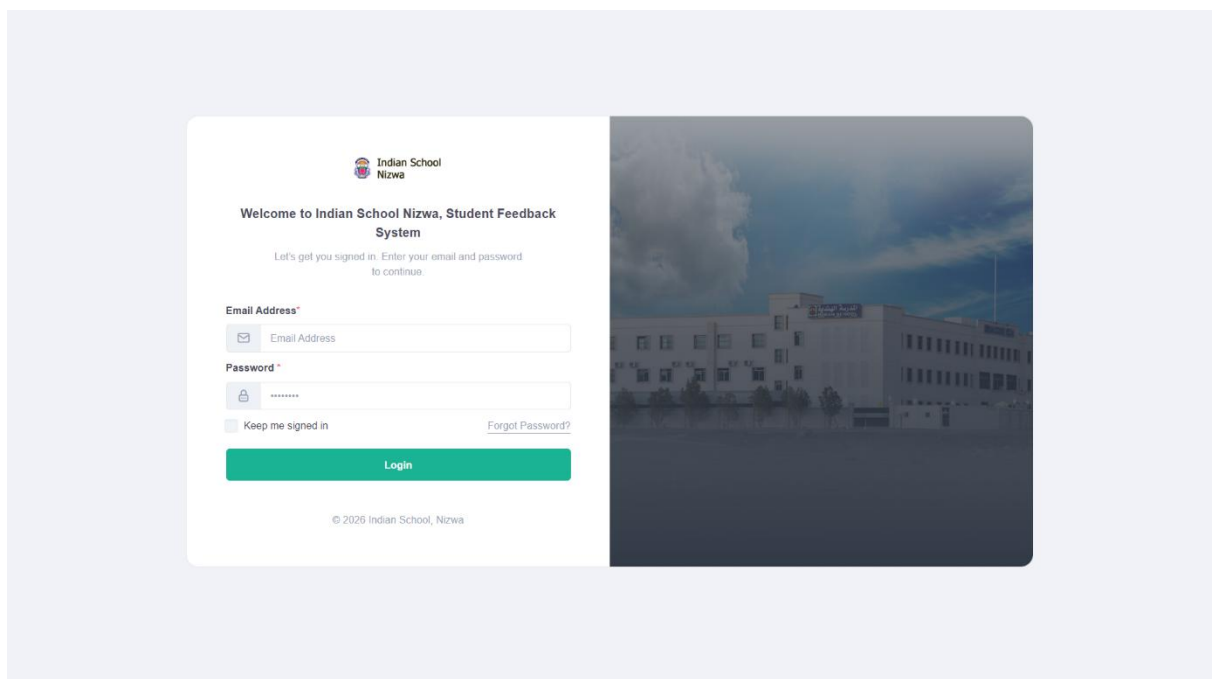


1. Enter the URL <https://feedback.isnizwa.org> in the google chrome browser. It is better to use the computer / laptop to give the feedback.



2. Enter the school email address and password. Password will be date of birth (YYYY-MM-DD) or ISN@Feedback@123 and click login



3. After login it will ask to select the academic year 2025 – 26.
